Convenient Care

Physical Therapy/Rehabilitation

Christie physical therapists work with our orthopaedic surgeons and other physicians to offer comprehensive care for patients in all phases of physical therapy. They provide preventive injury education, conditioning, and training, as well as injury evaluation and rehabilitation.

Our specialists also use a wide variety of physical therapy treatments, including heat therapy, cold therapy, electrical stimulation, and state-of-the-art rehabilitation equipment.

Orthopaedics

Surgeons in the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery provide surgical and non-surgical care for patients with diseases of the musculoskeletal system, as well as fractures, deformities, or injuries of the bones, muscles, joints, tendons, or spinal column.

Ancillary Services, including CT Scan and MRI

Computed Tomography (CT) scanning combines radiographic and computer technologies to produce an image of structures inside the body. This helps our doctors diagnose medical disorders and trauma conditions with increased speed and accuracy.

Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) uses advanced technology to create two-, three-, and four-dimensional pictures of organs, tissues, and fluids within the human body. This safe and painless technology enables our physicians to diagnose diseases in their earliest stages without exposing patients to any harmful radiation.

C U Sleep Clinic

Our Department of Sleep Medicine is fully equipped to diagnose and treat sleep disorders. Sleep studies are useful in uncovering hidden health issues such as obstructive sleep apnea, narcolepsy, periodic limb movements, restless leg syndrome, REM behavior disorder, sleepwalking, and other disturbances.

On-Site Pharmacy

Registered pharmacists are on hand to answer patients' questions about prescriptions. A computerized drug profile record is also maintained for each patient and may be of assistance in filing insurance claims or tax returns. The drug profile can also be valuable if your employees misplace a prescription.

In addition, Christie pharmacies provide delivery or mail service for your prescriptions. The Windsor facility is drive-up accessible and open on Saturdays.

Pain Management

Physicians in Christie Clinic's Department of Pain Management use interventional methods of therapy to treat patients who suffer from a variety of chronic and acute painful conditions. Our physicians have adopted a comprehensive approach to pain that encompasses multiple areas of medicine, including psychology, rehabilitation, and neurology.

On-Site Laboratory

Christie's laboratories are accredited by the College of American Pathologists and overseen by certified pathologists; the lab performs more than 650,000 tests each year. Patients are referred by a physician for all laboratory procedures, which are performed by a staff of lab technicians, medical technologists, phlebotomists, and EKG technicians.

Allergy/ENT

Christie otolaryngologists treat patients with disorders or illnesses of the ears, nose, throat, and neck. Our physicians are allergy specialists, diagnosing and treating patients' hypersensitivities to specific substances such as ragweed, pollen, or food. They also have experience in facial plastic and reconstructive surgery.
