

## Seeking <u>Healthy Adult Volunteers</u> for New Clinical Study Opportunity

We are recruiting participants <u>age 40 or older</u> who are due for <u>or</u> scheduled for a screening colonoscopy to take part in a clinical study that may determine if a new screening test can accurately and reliably detect colorectal cancer and pre-cancer.

## Who can participate?

We are looking for healthy volunteers who meet the following requirements:

- Generally healthy condition
- No history of colorectal cancer or other gastrointestinal conditions such as inflammatory bowel disease, ulcerative colitis or Crohn's disease
- Have not had a colonoscopy within the previous 9 years.

Enrollment will begin in September 2020 and includes a single clinic visit to assess full eligibility to participate (with optional blood draw), collection of a stool sample at home, and routine screening colonoscopy as per standard of care.
