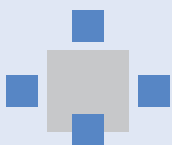
### Department of Neurology

He performs EMG/Nerve conduction studies for the diagnosis of diseases of nerves, muscles, cervical and lumbosacral spine diseases (neck and back radiculopathic pain) and neuromuscular junction disorders (Myasthenia Gravis). Dr. Habib injects botox for spasticity and muscle spasms due to stroke, multiple sclerosis, traumatic brain injury, spinal cord injury, cerebral palsy and for cervical dystonia and chronic migraine.
